

## **POSTDOCTORAL SCIENTIST – Skin and Cosmetics**

Shannon Applied Biotechnology Centre (Shannon ABC) is a research centre that is a collaboration between the Institute of Technology, Tralee and Limerick Institute of Technology and is funded as a Technology Gateway by Enterprise Ireland. Shannon ABC at Institute of Technology, Tralee have significant expertise in cell culture and in vivo testing of cosmetics.

Career-FIT PLUS aims to enhance the training and mobility of Experienced Researchers (ERs) through the undertaking of individually-driven, industry-focused research training projects which will be interdisciplinary and focused on the domain areas of the eligible Technology Centres and Technology Gateways in Ireland.

Shannon ABC invites applicants who wish to pursue a joint application for a Career-FIT Plus award.

The project proposed will build on the capability and equipment in place in the Skin Research Group in Shannon ABC and establish new techniques that can be utilised to screen innovative compounds for cosmetic and healthcare applications. This group have secured ~€1 million euro for industry focussed skin and cosmetics projects, almost €200,000 of cosmetic related research equipment and more recently have established a research collaboration with a Finnish University to develop a cosmetics network.
